Dear Fellow Active Member,

Re: Use of the bunkhouse

Our club policy and rules regarding junior members sleeping overnight in the bunkhouse is as follows:

- **All members under 18 years of age** are required to return a completed consent form to the Club Secretary before being able to stay over night.
- **All members under 15 years of age** are required to have a parent or guardian's supervision when staying overnight (except when on a school camp). Nominated guardians must be over 18 and must accept responsibility for the supervision of the club member. They may also be held jointly responsible for any inappropriate behaviour by the person in their care.

The committee wishes to point out that the club cannot guarantee supervision of juniors while staying in the bunkhouse.

Any club member consuming alcohol on club premises must do so responsibly. The club will not tolerate any members under 18 years of age drinking alcohol. Any member who is observed in breach of these rules will be required to explain their actions to the Executive Committee and could have their membership discontinued under section 16.2 of the club's constitution.

All active members must complete a Code of Conduct. This is aimed at ensuring the health, safety and wellbeing of all members and is in line with Surf Life Saving Australia Member Protection Policy. Once signed can you please return it to your patrol captain on your first patrol.

If any members or parents wish to discuss any aspect of this policy and consent process, please do not hesitate to contact the people below.
