## From the Chief Instructors

Hi all! It's nearly at the start of the season! We hope you're as excited as we are! Please read these important notes regarding training and assessment carefully.

# SKILLS MAINTENANCE (REQUAL):

We've had 2 sessions, and we have 3 more to go. Before attending one, please make sure you are a financial member, and complete online modules for each award you are updating. This can be done through: https://mt.lsv.com.au/skill maintenance/

Then please click step 02 - Book Practical and sign into a session you can make. This step is essential so we can limit sessions to 25 participants in accordance with LSV's COVID-19 policies. Future sessions are taking place on: - Saturday December 19th @ 11am - Saturday December 27th @ 1pm - Saturday January 2nd @11am If wishing to drive the ATV/SSV and/or the IRB, you must bring your Driver's License and Marine License.

### ADVANCED RESUSCITATION TECHNIQUES (ART) & FIRST AID AWARDS:

Wye is running our Advanced Resuscitation Techniques (ART) and First Aid awards on Saturday Dec 19th and Sunday Dec 20th respectively. These speciality awards will give you more prestige and responsibility to our patrols and we think they're a great fit for you to get up-skilled before the season! We encourage you to be involved in both (but if you can only make it to one that's fine!) Please let us know if you're keen, it would be a huge help to our patrol team to have a more qualified base that's better able to respond to situations we're faced with. They are great for emerging Patrol and Club leaders, and so the club and you would greatly benefit from you doing these when our member base is more skilled and qualified to handle emergencies. Both of these awards are also prerequisites for Silver and Gold Medallion Awards necessary for Patrol Captaincy and Paid Beach/Pool Lifeguard roles if you're interested in those pathways too.

Due to LSV requirements, both of these awards must be repeated every 3 years (in addition to requal), and this means that time may have crept up on some senior clubbies who will need to re-do the assessment to keep their award current. For all Lifesavers at all clubs, this is your responsibility as the Lifesaver to check on the SLSA Members' Portal - we can't chase up individual people as there's too many different people's schedules! If you're interested, or have any questions please let us know Enrolment links will be sent out to interested people.

#### **BRONZE & SRC UPDATE:**

We're also halfway through our Bronze & SRC online theory sessions. These will continue on Tuesday Dec 15th and Tuesday Dec 22nd.
